## About Associated Ministries

- **Project Interdependence**— helping family's access services such as the basic food program, health care, child care, drug treatment and other programs that help transition people from welfare to work.
- **Pierce County Asset Building Coalition** — helping people to strengthen their assets through financial literacy education, tax preparation and earned income tax credits.
- **Disaster Preparedness and Recovery** — mobilizing care teams from the faith community to help victims recover from natural disaster.
- **Paint Tacoma-Pierce Beautiful** — mobilizing volunteers to paint homes for the elderly and disabled.
- **Associated Ministries' Hunger Walk** — raising money for hunger relief in our community and abroad.

## **Assistance with Federal Income Tax Preparation**

The Pierce County Asset Building Coalition, a program of Associated Ministries, coordinates recruitment and training of tax preparation assistance volunteers and works with other organizations to make free tax preparation help available throughout Pierce County. Volunteers help prepare returns and are able to e-file them, which combined with direct deposit into a checking or savings account can mean cash in a family's hands within about ten days after filing. During tax season 2011-2012 millions of dollars from stimulus programs will be available to low- and moderate-income residents by filing for credits such as Earned Income Tax Credit, Child Tax Credit, First-time Homebuyers Credit, Education Credits, and Energy Credits.

- Free e-filing can also be done by the taxpayer him/herself by using the internet site [www.icanefile.org](http://www.icanefile.org), a trusted partner of the State of Washington.
- For assistance with returns for past tax years, where refunds may be awaiting a delayed filing, visit the local Internal Revenue Service office at 1201 Pacific Avenue, Tacoma (253-428-3518). There is no penalty for late filing where a refund is due.
